Dehesa is a multifunctional agroforestry system where pigs graze freely and feed on the acorns that fall from the holm oaks. Today, the dehesas are in decline due to overgrazing, scrubland, forest fires, and depopulation of the rural world. As healthy pigs need the dehesas, it is urgent to regenerate them, by repopulating the holm oaks, increasing biodiversity and changing current land management and return to the commons. Because its origins lie in the early Middle Ages when pastures were a communal asset.
